



## **2010 ESI Environmental Management System Training Modules**

The N.C. Division of Pollution Prevention and Environmental Assistance has developed EMS guidance materials and a timeline modeled on ISO 14001:2004 as a benefit to [N.C. Environmental Stewardship Initiative](#) members. To assist in meeting program criteria, five one-day classroom modules were created to provide training on core EMS elements. All modules will be held in Raleigh and are offered at no cost. Training will provide participants with in-depth discussions and hands-on exercises on the key elements of EMS implementation. DPPEA staff, along with other experienced environmental professionals, will conduct the EMS training.

### **The five training modules to be presented are:**

- Introduction to Environmental Management Systems and ISO 14001:  
**Feb. 3, 2010**
- Aspect and Impact Identification and Ranking: **March 3, 2010**
- Operational Control and Monitoring and Measurement: **April 7, 2010**
- Establishing Objectives and Targets/Environmental Management Programs:  
**May 5, 2010**
- Corrective and Preventive Action, Compliance with Legal & Other Requirements and Environmental Management System Auditing: **June 2, 2010**
