## For Example...

While working on the Florida Botanical Gardens project, Beers Skanska was restricted within 1,500' of an American bald eagle nesting site. The delay was worthwhile because the pair produced a baby eagle. Today, visitors to the Botanical Gardens site can usually see the young eagle flying around the Gardens and enjoying life.

During the construction of a religious training center located about 2 miles from the Gulf of Mexico, Beers Skanska was able to contain old concrete and wastewater resulting from the washout of 130 ready mix concrete trucks used for the largest concrete pour in South Florida. This environmental planning collected over 700 cubic yards of concrete waste that has been redirected to recycling facilities instead of landfills.
