Finishing Cleaning

Significant Aspects:

Animal Waste
Excess Sludge Accumulation

Potential Environmental Impacts:

Land, surface water, ground water, air quality

Work activities seek to protect against animal stress or loss, reduce lagoon loading, improve indoor air quality, and seek to prevent emergencies such as fire.

Report anything unusual to farm manager. Examples include rust in equipment, feeder deterioration, nipple waterer not working properly.

FINISHING FLOOR CLEANING BETWEEN GROUPS

After pigs are removed from entire finishing floor, hose down barn (wet with hose) using fresh water. This softens any dirt for easier removal.

Let soak for several hours and then return and pressure wash with fresh water.

Following pressure wash, disinfect with phenoyl based on farm manager instructions.

Do repair work as needed to feeders, curtains, penning equipment, or other.

Allow time for room to completely dry before introducing new pigs. This allows maximum effectiveness of product.
