### Statewide Paper Recycling Workshop Scheduled

RALEIGH – Key players in the paper recycling business will discuss the recycling process during a workshop set for Tuesday, Oct. 17, at the Enrichment Center at Bryan Park in Greensboro. Sponsored by the N.C. Division of Pollution Prevention and Environmental Assistance (DPPEA), the workshop is scheduled from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., followed by an optional tour of a local paper broker/processor at 3:30 p.m.

“Paper Recycling: A Journey Through the Loop” brings together experts in paper recycling, education and efficiency to offer insight into tools for heightened paper recovery in North Carolina. Issues to be highlighted include: methods for improving collection efficiency, contracting, identification of paper grades, buy recycled options, and teaching and motivating the public to recycle. Workshop speakers include representatives from the recycling world, industry and state and local government.

Local government officials seeking to improve current paper recycling programs or gain a better understanding of paper recycling options are urged to attend the workshop. Haulers, brokers, processors and mills interested in learning more about the other links in the paper recycling chain for more effective business interactions also stand to gain through workshop participation.
